## GT Chamber Choir to present Bach's B Minor Mass As a part of Church of the Redeemer Concert Series

J.S. Bach's monumental *Mass in B Minor* was completed during the last years of his life, and is generally considered to be one of the greatest masterworks of Western art music. In January, the Sarasota musical community will have the rare opportunity to hear the Florida premiere of the *B Minor Mass* (Breitkopf urtext edition, edited by Joshua Rifkin) with organ.

The Georgia Tech Chamber Choir, one of the finest collegiate chamber ensembles in the Southeast, will present this rarely-performed masterpiece on **Sunday, January 16 at 5.15 PM** in the Episcopal Church of the Redeemer. GT Director of Choral Activities Dr. Jerry Ulrich will conduct the chorus and student soloists, accompanied by professional organist Paul Carroll. The Georgia Tech Chamber Choir was founded in 1998, and regularly performs major works both unaccompanied and with orchestra. Recent performances have included *Copland In the Beginning of Creation*, Ginastera *Lamentations of Jeremiah*, Corigliano *Fern Hill*, and Bach *Cantata 80*.
